

Aqua Aquaria India 2013

RGCA actively participated in Aqua Aquaria 2013 organized by the Marine Products Export Development Authority held at the Loyola college grounds, Vijayawada during 8th -10th February'2013. The theme pavilion covered an area of 540 sqm (5600 sq. ft approx.) at the event was set up by RGCA. The pavilion showcased the various Research & Development activities pursued by RGCA that could be adopted by the industry. The large marketable sized live fish, Shrimp and a Mud Crab Mangrove sanctuary displayed by RGCA attracted large crowds that included farmers, technocrats, students, researchers as well as the general public. RGCA also exhibited seeds of various species, Artemia cysts and Biomass, Open Sea cages for the benefit of farmers. The entire system was supported by a Recirculation Aquaculture System that assisted in providing a stress free environment to the displayed fish during the period.



A Seafood stall “**Machilipattinam**” was put up by RGCA that served different dishes of cooked seafood that included Seabass, Cobia and

Tilapia and also carried out promotional sale of frozen Cobia, Seabass and Tilapia as whole deheaded and degutted fish, steaks and fillets harvested fresh for the event from the RGCA R & D Units. This stall attracted unprecedented crowds during the event.
